

NET ZERO COMMITMENT STATEMENT

This net zero commitment statement is our pledge, by Wallington Cars and Couriers, to reduce greenhouse gas emissions to as close to zero as possible by 2050, and to then offset any residual emissions through verifiable carbon removals, aligning with the goal of limiting global temperature rise to 1.5°C above pre-industrial levels. This statement, typically outlines strategies for deep emission cuts, setting science-based targets, and ensuring transparency in measuring, monitoring, and reporting their climate impact and progress.

Key Components of a Net Zero Commitment Statement

Target Date:

It is the intention of Wallington Cars and Couriers that our net zero goal will be achieved, by 2050.

• Emissions Reduction:

A commitment to reducing emissions across all scopes (operational and embodied) by a significant percentage, with the aim of removing all non-essential emissions.

Carbon Removals/Offsets:

A plan to compensate for any remaining emissions by removing greenhouse gases from the atmosphere through methods like growing forests.

• Scope of Emissions:

Clarity on whether the commitment applies to direct emissions, indirect emissions from purchased energy, or all emissions across a value chain.

• Measurement & Reporting:

A commitment to measure, monitor, and transparently report on climate impacts, often using established frameworks like the Greenhouse Gas Protocol.

Alignment with Science:

Endorsement of science-based targets, such as those provided by the Science Based Targets Initiative (SBTi), to ensure the commitment is consistent with a 1.5°C future.

Action & Strategy:

Details on the actions and transformations (e.g., renewable energy, circularity, sustainable procurement) that will be undertaken to achieve the target.
